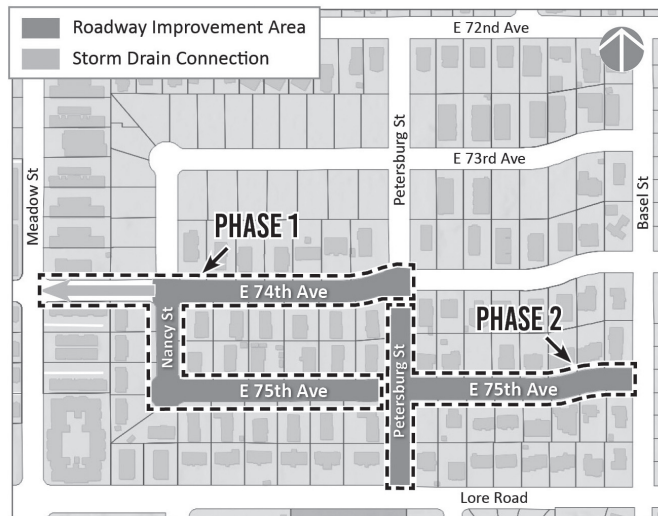


Project Update

- The Design Study Memorandum (DSM) has been completed, and can be viewed on the project website.

- Design was recently started, and the preliminary phase 1 design is expected to be completed by April 2026.
